Dear Provider,

Aetna Better Health of Florida would like to remind you of our billing guidelines for Bacterial Urine Culture Testing, CPT 87086 and 87088. A bacterial urine culture is a laboratory procedure performed on a urine specimen to establish the probable etiology of a presumed urinary tract infection. This is not to be confused with CPT codes 81000-81005 which are used to describe Urinalysis testing.

Dx Code	Description
87086	Culture, bacterial; quantitative, colony count, urine.
87088	Culture, bacterial; with isolation and presumptive identification of each isolates, urine.

According to our policy, which is based on CMS Policy, in order to be reimbursed for CPT 87086, appropriate ICD-10 codes must be used. The ICD codes listed below are the top diagnosis codes currently utilized by ordering physicians for the limited coverage of CPT 87086.
