Dear Provider,

Aetna Better Health of Florida would like to share information with you regarding claims submitted with a Type of Bill Code ending in "0".

The Type of Bill Code is made up of 4 digits. This four-digit alphanumeric code provides three specific pieces of information after a leading zero.

- First Digit = Leading zero. Ignored by CMS
- Second Digit = Type of facility
- Third Digit = Type of care
- Fourth Digit = Sequence of this bill in this episode of care. Referred to as a "frequency" code

When the 4th digit (Frequency Code) of the Type of Bill Code is billed with a zero (i.e. 012<u>0</u> or 021<u>0</u>), this indicates a period of non-payable confinement or termination of care. No payment should be expected for the period of time billed.
