Get Your COVID-19 Vaccine Now!





All Chicago residents 12 years and older are now eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccine. Minors under the age of 18 will need a parent or legal guardian present to receive the vaccine, unless an exception applies.*

Why get the COVID-19 vaccine:

- The COVID-19 vaccine is EFFECTIVE at protecting you, your family and your friends against COVID-19
- The COVID-19 vaccine is SAFE and cannot give you the COVID-19 virus
- The COVID-19 vaccine is FREE and open for all Chicagoans 12 and older, regardless of insurance or immigration status
