


### **2023 Pay for Performance incentives**

We're pleased to introduce our 2023 Pay for Performance (P4P) Program. P4P rewards participating primary care providers (PCPs), pediatricians, behavioral health providers and OB-GYNs who perform recommended services for key HEDIS® measures.

The performance measures focus on preventive services, prenatal care, postpartum care, management of chronic diseases and follow-up care after hospitalizations.

#### **EPSDT/Bright Futures services**

Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis and Treatment (EPSDT) — also known as Bright Futures services — are federally mandated preventive care services for Medicaid members under age 21.

All primary care providers are required to provide comprehensive health care, screening and preventive services for children. We're pleased to offer tips for EPSDT care including:


### **Oral health care tips**

# Updated timeframe for retroactive authorization disputes

We've updated the submission timeframe for retroactive authorization disputes (post-service). Effective December 1, 2022, a dispute must be requested within 60 calendar days from the date of denial.
