Follow-Up After High Intensity Care for Substance Use Disorder (FUI)

This HEDIS® measure looks at the percentage of acute inpatient hospitalizations, residential treatment or detoxification visits for members ages 13 and older seen for a substance use disorder who had a follow-up visit or service for substance use disorder. Two rates are reported:

- 1. Within 7 days after visit or discharge, member received a follow-up for substance abuse disorder.
- 2. Within 30 days after visit or discharge, member received a follow-up for substance abuse disorder.

Numerator codes for FUI

There is a large list of approved NCQA codes used to identify services included in the FUI measure. Below are a few examples of approved codes. For a complete list, see NCQA.org.

Strategies for providers

- ✓ Use appropriate clinical documentation and correct coding.
- ✓ Maintain appointment availability for patient with recent hospital admissions.
- ✓ Explain the importance of follow-up to your patients.
- ✓ Support the coordination of assistance for members with competing social demands including childcare, transportation, and housing that otherwise prevent them from attending treatment appointments.
- ✓ Reach out to patients who do not keep initial appointments and reschedule them as soon as possible.
- ✓ Telehealth visits with the appropriate principal diagnosis will meet the follow-up criteria.
- ✓ Submit accurate and timely claims and encounter data.
