## Aetna Better Health® of Illinois

Long-Term Care Facilities - Nursing Facilities billing for telehealth originating site fee

Aetna Better Health<sup>®</sup> of Illinois follows <u>HFS guidance</u> allowing Long-Term Care Facilities - Nursing Facilities to bill an originating site facility fee for telehealth services provided during the Public Health Emergency (PHE).

## Instructions for billing a telehealth facility fee

- Use the National Provider Identifier (NPI) for the facility's durable medical equipment (DME) oxygen supplier enrollment. Telehealth claims are billed as a professional service. **Do not use the facility NPI that is used for normal facility billing**.
- Use Procedure Code Q3014 Telehealth Originating Site Facility Fee.
- Use Procedure Code modifier "CR" to bypass the **SMART Act** 2.7% rate reduction on the service.

Services rendered between **3/9/2020-11/30/2020** should be documented within the health plan billing template, which will be emailed to you by your Provider Experience representative. Please email the completed template to our HIPAA mailbox at <u>ABHILHIPAA@AETNA.com</u>. The following documentation should be included:

- 2018 W9
- Payment mailing address
- Q3014 billing template
  - Contact your Provider Experience representative for a copy of the health plan billing template
  - All fields must be completed
