**PURPOSE:** Per Aetna Better Health of Illinois Policy, which is based on the AMA/CPT manual, According to the AMA CPT Manual, moderate sedation services performed by a second physician/provider should only be reported in a facility setting.

## STATEMENT OF OBJECTIVE/OVERVIEW:

When a second physician other than the health care professional performing the diagnostic or therapeutic services provides moderate (conscious) sedation in the facility setting, the second physician reports the associated moderate sedation procedure/service. When these services are performed by the second physician in a non-facility setting, the associated moderate sedation services are not reported.

## **DEFINITIONS:**

Conscious Sedation	A drug-induced depression of consciousness during which patients
	respond purposefully to verbal commands, either alone or
	accompanied by light tactile stimulation. No interventions are required
	to maintain a patent airway, and spontaneous ventilation is adequate.
	Cardiovascular function is usually maintained. For example, a patient
	undergoing the reduction of a dislocated large joint (shoulder) may
	require this form of sedation to tolerate the procedure.
