COVID-19 vaccines for children

Health care providers are parents' most trusted source of information on vaccinations for children. With COVID-19 vaccination now available for children ages 6 months and older, Aetna Better Health® of Illinois encourages pediatric providers to offer COVID-19 vaccines in their offices.

Vaccination for children ages 6 months and older is recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). The Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna vaccines may be administered to children in this age group. See clinical considerations for each vaccine.

How to make COVID-19 vaccination available to your patients

- Enroll to become a COVID-19 vaccine provider.
 - Vaccines for Children (VFC) providers can enroll within I-CARE under the COVID tab/enrollment.
 - Non-VFC providers who do not already have I-CARE access can use the I-CARE
 enrollment packet to request it. Once enrolled in I-CARE, access the COVID tab to
 complete both the CDC and IDPH COVID-19 vaccine provider agreements.
- Order vaccine through I-CARE or request through the state's vaccine transfer program.

Once your office has vaccine available, be sure to let families know and discuss vaccination during age-appropriate visits. A list of Aetna Better Health of Illinois members who are unvaccinated is available on the COVID-19 report in the **Availity provider portal**.
