Rate Changes for Physician Administered Drugs – April 2023

Effective with dates of service on and after April 1, 2023, Medicaid rates for physician-administered drugs (PADs) with Medicare Part B rates, will reflect the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) updated pricing methodology for Medicare Part B drugs/biologicals.

Pricing guidelines for unlisted procedure code drugs will remain the same. Any HCPCS codes that pertain to drugs on the High Dollar Rare Disease Drug Reimbursement list will follow the pricing in General Bulletin <u>22097</u>.

Should a long-acting reversible contraception (LARC) product have a price change, the updated price will be retroactive to that product's price change effective date.

Note: The effective date of the policy is April 1, 2023. The implementation of State policy by the KanCare managed care organizations (MCOs) may vary from the date noted in the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) bulletins. The **KanCare Open Claims Resolution Log** on the KMAP <u>Bulletins</u> page documents the MCO system status for policy implementation and any associated reprocessing completion dates once the policy is implemented.
