NEW POLICY UPDATES CLINICAL PAYMENT, CODING AND POLICY CHANGES

We regularly augment our clinical, payment and coding policy positions as part of our ongoing policy review processes.

Effective for dates of service beginning September 21, 2021:

Genetic Testing-

Based on professional society guidelines and federal agencies (American College of Medical Genetics & Genomics as well as the American College of Obstetrics and Gynecology, FDA and CPIC) we will not cover genetic tests that are experimental, investigational, or unproven (EIU). For example, there is insufficient evidence that the use of the Corus CAD genetic testing will impact therapeutic decision making in the clinical management of a patient. In addition, we require that the diagnosis is appropriate for the genetics test.
