'Smile For Life Oral Health' Services for Medicaid members 6 months to 5 years old

The Louisiana Department of Health (LDH) has implemented a process improvement program for Medicaid with the goal of increasing the number of eligible enrollees ages 6 months to 5 years who receive **fluoride varnish application** by their Primary Care Provider. This implementation can assist with dental caries and other diseases associated with dental neglect in children.

Coding requirements

The LDH is allowing primary care providers who have completed the "Smile For Life Oral Health" certification to bill **CPT Code 99188** for the application of Fluoride Varnish. The Fluoride Varnish **can be applied at each visit and there is no limit** so every interaction can be an opportunity to help improve their oral health for life.
