

# OHR MSY Flow Chart

## MSY Applications

Communication between the CME and the Family and Children First Council is a key component to ensure well-planned transitions of care coordination.

### MSY Program Criteria

- OHR Eligible (CANS Complete)
- Youth is at risk of custody relinquishment
- Youth must have multi-system needs
- OHR (to include flex funds), Medicaid, PASSS, insurance and all other financial resources reasonably exhausted
- Youth must be between 0-20 years of age
- The family/guardian must be engaged and actively participate in the youth's treatment

### OHR Intervention and Services

- Tiered Care Coordination
- Family Voice and Choice - family has chosen OHR CC and not CC with another entity
- In-home Supports
- Community Services
- 1915c Waiver

If residential treatment/Q RTP is indicated:

- Community resources must be reasonably exhausted
- Least restrictive setting
- For the least amount of time necessary
- Family engagement is required

Meet with the family/guardian to complete required releases of information, CANS assessment, discuss care coordination to include current care team members (i.e., FCFC, CPS, CBDD)

Discuss service/support options with funding options and complete the Child Family Centered Care Plan

Complete MSY application and gather all required supporting documentation

Submit completed MSY application & documentation to Aetna MSY Team

Aetna's MSY team reviews application and submits to ODM for Technical assistance and/or funding consideration – Aetna & the CME CC is informed of the review date

ODM MSY team will review the MSY application and render a determination. All determinations will be shared with the Aetna MSY Team and CME CC

Funding **NOT** Authorized

Aetna or CME Care Coordinator will reconvene the Child and Family Care Team to determine alternative strategies to support the youth and family

Funding Authorized

Aetna or CME Care Coordinator will outreach to the identified provider(s) on the application to coordinate the youth's care

Updates and continued funding requests will be completed by the CME Care Coordinator and submitted timely to Aetna
