Back-to-school checkups can help members earn rewards

Back-to-school appointments offer a valuable opportunity to engage families in preventive care. During these visits, providers can help ensure children receive recommended screenings and services, complete school-related health forms, and connect families with resources available through their health plan.

When appropriate, encourage families to:

- Schedule annual **preventive** care visits
- Complete school or **sports participation forms** during a well-child visit
- Learn about **rewards and extra benefits** available through their health plan

Help families make the most of their benefits

Members can:

- Complete a well-child exam to earn rewards for completing visits from birth to 20 years old
- Stay active and earn a \$100 allowance each year for eligible sports and recreational activities
- GO (get outside) with a \$40 allowance to purchase an Oklahoma zoo or state park pass
- And more!



School and sports physicals can count as well-child visits when all required well-child exam elements are completed, documented, and billed using the appropriate preventive medicine CPT codes.
