Frequently asked questions

What type of gift card will I receive?

Gift cards are reloadable and can be used at any participating retailer found on **mybenefitscenter.com**. Some restrictions apply.

Can I redeem my card for cash?

No. Your card can only be used to purchase allowed products at a store. However, the card is reloadable for future programs and should NOT be thrown away.

Their provider can help keep them healthy. | Children ages 0-15 months | 6 well visits prior to turning 15 months of age. 6th visit must be completed between 7/31/25 and 12/31/25 | \$30 Gift Card |
| Childhood Immunizations (Flu Shot) Vaccines keep your child protected against various diseases such as the flu. Completing immunizations on schedule are important to your child's health. | Children ages 0-2 years | A flu shot completed prior to 2nd birthday. Flu shot must be completed between 7/1/25 and 12/31/25 | \$30 Gift Card |
| Immunizations for Adolescents (HPV) The HPV vaccine can protect your child against various cancers that can occur later in life. Completing immunizations on schedule are important to your child's health. | Adolescents ages 9-13 years | Complete the HPV vaccine series prior to 13th birthday (2 or 3 dose series). Final dose must be given between 7/1/25 and 12/31/25 | \$30 Gift Card |

Remember, we must receive a claim from your child's doctor to send the reward. Only enrollees who have Aetna Better Health as their primary (main) insurance are eligible to earn rewards.
