Your environment and conditions surrounding where you are born, live, learn, play, and work can impact your health. These conditions are known as Social Determinants of Health (SDoH).

There are different types of SDoH:

Economic Stability

- Being able to afford healthy food, healthcare, and housing
- Having access to high quality childcare opportunities so parents can find and keep jobs

Education Access and Quality

- Being able to access a good school or attend college
 - Children have a greater chance of getting a good paying job

Healthcare Access and Quality

- Living close to primary care providers and health care providers who offer services like cancer screenings
- Getting the education needed to understand your healthcare needs

Neighborhood and Built Environment

- Living in a safe neighborhood
- · Having access to safe air, water, and no lead exposure

Social and Community Context

- · Having the support from your family and community
- Fostering good relationships and not being a victim of bullying peers
